

Supracondylar Humerus wiring sawbones workshop. Wiring techniques, Instructional technique demonstration, tricks and tips, alternative treatment

Ankle and proximal tibial physeal injuries sawbones workshop. Triplane injuries, Tillaux fractures, other physeal injuries, tricks and tips

Instructional Interactive Practical Simulation Session 6:

Lateral entry nailing for adolescent femoral fractures (Pedi nail) clear sawbones workshop. Tricks and tips, case discussion, indications

Instructional Interactive Practical Simulation Session 7:

Hip Spica application technique with toddler model, table and positioning, pitfalls, tricks and tips. Pavlik Harness application for infant femoral fractures, case discussions.

Instructional Interactive Practical Simulation Session 8:

Ponseti casting for CTEV with deformity models. Boots and Bar application. Tricks and tips, case discussion of relapse and recalcitrant deformities.

Instructional Interactive Practical Simulation Session 9:

SCFE percutaneous pinning simulation model. Radiologically assisted custom made model of a moderate slip (note lead protection will be required for this session). Tricks and tips, pitfalls, options for severe slips.
