

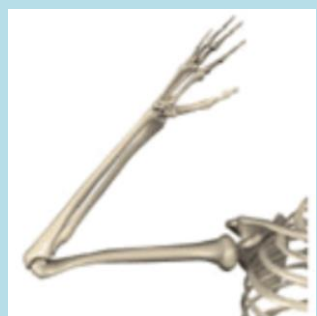
Fingertip to Shoulder Workshop
